A child's first years at school shape the rest of their academic career. This is why we hire only certified and experienced teachers *and* assistants that have university degrees in education. We send teachers to Reggio-Emilia once a year and we offer continuous professional development.



1 Children as capable

Children are born capable of learning, exploring, and understanding their environment. Each child has the right to bring their own experiences and ideas into the classroom.

2 Teachers as partners

Teachers are there to support and extend the children's explorations. The teacher does not dictate what the students will know, but instead observes and documents what and how the students choose to learn.

3 Environment as a third teacher

A child's environment must be stimulating, malleable, welcoming, and safe to maximize their ability and desire to learn independently.

4 Curriculum as a journey

The children's interests, abilities and prior experiences guide the curriculum day by day. The curriculum coordinator works with the teachers and students to make sure each child is meeting developmental milestones and is ready to transition to kindergarten.
